This is a year long programme which will be integrated into existing curriculums to assist boys to understand their own work and self-efficiency. The programme will also allow the opportunity for boys to learn new skills of how to deal with issues that may challenge them in the future.


The Outdoor Education Programme will take place in Harataunga Coromandel On Wednesday 7th April to Friday 9th April 2021. Students will need to be at Kura by 8.30am for Karakia and will leave from Harataunga at 9.00am and will return to Kura on Friday at 3.00pm.
